Intensive Case Management/ Wraparound

We work with children and adolescents with serious emotional and behavioral needs.

Intensive Case Managers and Parent Partners team up with youth and their families to develop plans that support them in achieving their vision. The process builds on the families' strengths, needs, and culture.

Intensive Case Managers and Parent Partners use a strengths based approach in assessment, service planning, and coordination of resources.

Minimum 4 contacts per month with child/youth.

Supportive Case Management

We work with children and adolescents identified as needing additional supports due to emotional needs.

Minimum 2 contacts per month with child/youth.

Crisis Services

Home Based Crisis Intervention (HBCI)

We work with children at imminent risk for hospitalization who are referred by a service provider. HBCI is an intensive program in which therapists and family develop a plan for treatment.

Services are provided for 4-6 week duration. Initial two weeks are crisis stabilization.

Youth Emergency Services (YES)

We make home visits to assess mental health needs of children and adolescents. We provide crisis planning and stabilization and make necessary referrals to community resources.

Duration of this services is 1-5 visits.
